VITA Volunteers Needed!!

Training will be held **Dec. 10-14** at the **Dahlgren Fleet & Family Support Center**

Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) season is fast approaching. If you or someone in your command, is interested in becoming a volunteer, please call to register for the training. This training is necessary to complete the mandated IRS certification tests which must be completed in order to serve as a VITA volunteer.

Volunteers will work directly with the public helping patrons complete their taxes using the Navy provided TAXWISE software on a one-on-one basis. Clients will be Active-duty military, their family members, military retirees and/or their family members. Volunteering for VITA will also require your time. Tax season will start approximately the middle of January and will run through April 15.

Appointments will be scheduled and completed at the Fleet and Family Support Center (FFSC). Volunteers will choose their schedule and appointments will be made during that time. This commitment is required to accommodate all patrons in need of service. Most appointment times will be Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. - 4 p.m. If you would like to volunteer evening hours, an attempt will be made to accommodate this schedule. A few Saturday afternoons might be requested at the start of the season so that we can meet the needs of the single sailors as much as possible early in the season. Commitment to the times you submit is vital to the success of the program.

This program is an important way to help others keep their money in their pockets and learn more about your own taxes at the same time. This program needs your volunteer service to be successful! We need your time to provide this great service.
